The Château Grand Moulin Macquin belongs to Rambeaud family, winegrowers since 2010. The vineyard of 6 hectares is on Saint George village, 3 km from Saint-Emilion and 40 km east of Bordeaux-South exposition. The vines have an average age of 30 years and the planting density is 5 500 vines per hectare.



SOIL:

Silty clay soil and clay-limestone subsoil. South facing slopes.

GRAPE VARIETY:

60 % Merlot 40 % Cabernet Sauvignon



Integrated viticulture (HVE), 50hl per hectare, green harvest leaf stripping. Machine harvest, high quality density sorting, 20 days maceration in thermoregulated tanks. Sulfits free process up to the ageing phase. Aging during 12 to 24 months in concrete tanks.





A crisp and pleasant wine. Fresh and fruity flavours on the nose, soft and generous on the palate.



Ideal with cold meats, lamb, or cassoulet.



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
