

HISTORY

Montesquieu, winemaker of Graves area at « La Brede » was the first to promote this appellation which is the oldest one in Bordeaux. Vignobles Lesgourgues acquired this Graves historical cru in 1997.

SILICEOUS GRAVES AND CLAVEY GRAVES SOILS

VINEYARD

- 54 acres of red over the 61 acres of the property
- Pruning: double guyot
- Soils are worked mechanically without using herbicides
- Organic manure (faba beans, mustard plant and oats)

VINIFICATION AND AGEING

- Maceration 15 days at 86° fermentation
- Daily pumping over
- 12 months in french oak barrel 25% of new oak in different sizes of barrels: 225L, 400L plus two wooden vats of 50HL

TASTING NOTES

Blend: 70% Merlot 30% Cabernet Sauvignon

"The bouquet reveals some freshness through red berries and spices, followed by empyreumatic notes. On the palate, the evolution of the wine expresses its great freshness. The tannins are precise and the aromatic expression carries through to the finish." Yves Beck
