France. Pays d'Oc, Languedoc-Roussillon (Hérault) and Charentes (South South West, appellation Cognac)



50% Pays d'Oc Sauvignon. Harvested on marly soils and gravelly clay providing full ample flavours and aromatic freshness. The other 50% comes from Sauvignon from petite Champagne vintages (South South West, Cognac) from limestone and clay and limestone-clay soils which give to the wine a steely character and aromatic persistence.

Exclusively matured in stainless steel tanks to express all the freshness and character of the fruit.

The palate is fresh and beautifully perfumed with a well balances finish.
