2021 Weemala Pinot Noir

Weemala is both an Aboriginal word for 'good view' and the name of our vineyard in the Central Ranges of NSW. As the birds that live here can testify, it does have a bloody good view. Right now you've got a pretty good view of our Pinot Noir. Bright, light and fruity. Deep garnet in colour, with allspice, red flowers and strawberry aroma. Mouth filling red cherries and rosemary on the palette with a lingering finish, definitely leaving you wanting more.

VINEYARD

The Pinot Noir grapes for this dry red were harvested from vineyards at 13.34° Baumé on the 17th March 2021 from vines in Adelaide Hills.

WINEMAKING

The pinot noir is comprised of 5 clones: 777, MV6, 114, 667 and 115. Fermentation was in a combination of rotary fermenters, spun twice per day and concrete open fermenters pumped over twice a day. The grapes were then cold soaked for 2 days. Fermentation was by wild yeast. The wine was pressed off skins after 10 days, it then finished natural malolactic fermentation in stainless steel. The wine was filtered before bottling.
